- Positions trucks for loading or unloading, following crew signals and verifying correct alignment of the vehicle and equipment.
- Completes required paperwork for deliveries
- Maintains a detailed maintenance log for all equipment and vehicles, documenting scheduled and completed preventative maintenance, post-job inspections, and repairs to ensure optimal performance.

WORK ENVIRONMENT: The position resides in a construction warehouse and light manufacturing setting. Possible exposure to grease, oil, dust, and the like. The individual must follow all safety requirements carefully. PHYSICAL DEMANDS: While performing the duties of this job, the individual is frequently required to sit, stand, walk, talk or hear; uses hands to finger, handle, or touch objects or controls. On occasion the individual may be required to stoop, bend or reach above the shoulders. The individual must be able to lift up to 60 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus. Work is performed in dusty and not fully air conditioned or heated warehouse; works with and around warehouse equipment. Noise level ranges from low to moderate. The physical requirements described here are representative of those that must be met by an individual to successfully perform the essential functions of this position.
